
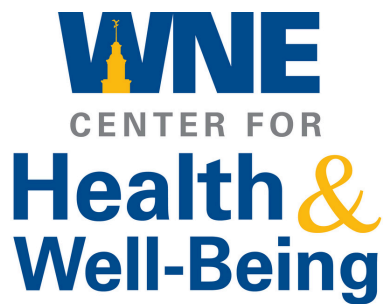

Step 1	<p>Log on to patient portal wne.mediatconnect.com</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>OR</u></p> <p>Scan QR code to log on to the patient portal</p> 
Step 2	<p>From the homepage, go to the Forms* section to complete the following forms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consent for Treatment • Health History • Tuberculosis (TB) Screening Questionnaire** <p>*These forms will need to be completed directly in the patient portal **If you answer Yes on the TB Screening Questionnaire, please upload a TB test or IGRA</p>
Step 3	<p>On the homepage, go to the Uploads section to download the following forms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physical Exam • Immunization Record <p>Using the WNE Physical Exam and Immunization Record form is not required. We also accept Physical Exam and Immunization documentation from outside providers.</p>
Step 4	<p>Have your medical provider complete and sign the forms with all the required information making sure to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your name • Your date of birth • Date of the exam • Signature by the medical provider
Step 5	<p>Once complete, upload the completed documents to the patient portal in the Uploads section:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go to the Uploads section • Choose Select File next to the name of the document you are uploading and choose the appropriate file in your phone/computer to upload • To successfully upload, files should be JPEG or PDF • Each file will only need to be uploaded once • Once all documents are selected, scroll to the bottom of the page and select the blue Upload button



New Student Health Requirements Checklist

Use this checklist to keep track of your submitted health requirements

Tdap- 1 dose; given within the last 10 years

Hepatitis B- 3 doses; positive titer proving immunity; or
2 doses of Heplisav-B

MMR-2 doses; or positive titers proving immunity

Varicella- 2 doses; or positive titer proving immunity

Meningitis- 1 dose MenACWY (formerly MCV4) required
for students 21 years of age or younger

Physical Exam- A physical exam completed by a licensed
medical provider within 1 year of enrollment

Tuberculosis (TB) Test- If you answered "yes" to any of the
TB screening questions, submit IGRA results or a TB Skin test

Consent for Treatment form (For 18+ only) or
Minor Consent for Treatment form (for students under 18)

**Physical exams are offered at the Center for Health and Well-Being Health Services with no out of pocket expense if needed. You may schedule directly on our patient portal
